**DAY OF PRAYER FOR PEACE**

The Bishops of England and Wales invite us to make this Sunday a day of prayer for world peace, using the theme proposed by Pope Francis: ***Migrants and Refugees – Seekers of Peace.*** Sadly, we are used to images of those driven from their homelands by warfare or famine that we risk being desensitised both to their pain and their aspirations. Yet these are our brothers and sisters; they seek what we all seek - food and shelter, a safe home and hope for the future.
