### 2017 ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT

Income - £140,492

Expenditure - £130,999

A full detailed report can be found on the notice board at the back of the church.

The recent 5 year review of the Church, Presbytery and Hall buildings, has shown many serious defects that needed to be rectified. At the back of the church, there are some photographs of the damage to internal and external areas. Some of the more severely damaged areas have now been repaired. This cost £17,500 last year (2017). However we envisage that we will need to spend approx £20,000 this year to repair the rest of the damaged areas. Any ideas of fund raising for these much needed repairs would be greatly appreciated
