APPEAL FROM NUNEATON FOODBANK The need for supplies is increasing. We are giving out more food than we are taking in. If you have any items such as tinned potatoes, fruit juice, jars of coffee, tinned fruit, biscuits, puddings etc it would be much appreciated. Thank vou.

BEDWORTH FOODBANK In the last six months Bedworth Foodbank has experienced an overall increase of 50% in the number of people referred to it by partner agencies, such as Citizens Advice and Warwickshire Welfare. Of particular concern is the fact that it is families that are in the greatest need with the number of children fed up by 93% and families comprising 54% of cases handled. The generosity of the people of Bedworth has enabled the foodbank to meet this demand so far but donations of non perishable food are still needed as there are no signs of the demand reducing. A huge thank you to everyone who has supported Bedworth Foodbank over the past six months either through the collecting box in the church entrance hall or that behind till 15 in Tesco.
