Cardinal John Henry Newman

On Tuesday 12 February 2019 Pope Francis cleared the way for the canonisation of the much-loved educationalist Cardinal John Henry Newman. Cardinal Vincent Nichols welcomed the news that Cardinal Newman will be declared a saint.

"Newman's exploration of faith, depth of personal courage, intellectual clarity and cultural sensitivity make him a deeply admired follower of Christ. For me the truly remarkable nature of this moment is that this is an English parish priest being declared a saint. During his life the people of Birmingham recognised his holiness and lined the streets at the time of his burial."

Cardinal John Henry Newman was beatified by Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI on his historic state visit to the UK in September 2010.
