It is the Church's tradition that we do not eat meat on a Friday but during Lent it would be good if we could consider all forms of fasting, the custom of giving something up for Lent is a token gesture where as to live Lent properly means to fast for the whole season. ALMSGIVING:

Almsgiving it linked to fasting! We deny ourselves in order that we might give to others. Giving of what we have surplus to our needs is not really giving at all. We give to others as an act of love, it is this real act of love that might begin to change the world and redress the imbalance of wealth in the world. It gives us the opportunity to reflect on our own greed and selfishness.

PRAYER:

Prayer reminds us that it is in God that we find true peace and not in the passing things of this world

We will continue the recent tradition of Holy Hour and Benediction on Thursday evenings 8 - 9pm. Stations of the Cross will be every Friday evening at 7.00pm and Sunday afternoons at 5.00pm.
