DEAR PARISHIONERS, Just to keep you informed:

Works taken place at Bedworth

There is a water leak underground somewhere on the presbytery side. This is causing the pressure to go down. We are still investigating this. Also we are still awaiting quotes for the damp work to be done in both sides of the church. Once this is done we will buy new carpet for the church and redecorate.

Works at Bulkington

In preparation for the Consecration of the Church in June, the Church will need rewiring, additional lighting, re-decoration, a new carpet a new Baptismal font and Consecration crosses and Candle holders. We are still awaiting quotes for this work but I am very hopeful that work will commence immediately after Easter. We will need to form a planning committee for the event itself and I will be thinking about this after the visitation.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WESTON LANE Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Weston Lane, Bulkington from the junction with the B4029 Bedworth Road to the junction with B4112 Nuneaton Road, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching and associated works. The Order will commence on 15 April 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 April 2019. Please Note: The works will be carried out between 08.00hrs and 16.00hrs.
