DEAR PARISHIONERS, Just to keep you informed:

As you can see the works in the Church are now nearly complete ready for the Dedication. The Parish Hall floor will be sanded and sealed and then the new curtains will be fitted. If you wish to attend the Consecration/Dedication for catering purposes, please could I ask you to sign the list at the back of the church so that I will be able to give final numbers.

At Bedworth we have to find the source of the leak before the damp can be treated. I have also been advised that many of the parts needed for the heating system are now obsolete and that after 8 years the whole heating system will need to be replaced. As this system originally cost around £40,000 a new system will be a considerable cost. So much money has been spent on the present heating system and it is just so unreliable. This is very disappointing and frustrating. The main doors at the back also now need to be replaced before the winter, as well the damp, decoration, and new carpet. These things all come at once but it is important to remember that money needs to be saved and spent wisely. Having an old church is wonderful but it takes a lot of money. I just wanted to keep you all informed!
