OLA NIGHT SHELTER FOR THE HOMELESS

The Night Shelter starts on the 1st December until 29th February and Our Lady's is the first one. We, along with 5 other local churches and the mosque, provide shelter for up to 12 homeless people (usually men) over the coldest winter months. **Arthur Kelly** has volunteered to coordinate but he needs **your** help. At present he has a sleep over team of 5 to cover 13 weeks! There should be at least 2 volunteers to sleep over. If we could get another 20 volunteers it would mean just one sleep over!
