Introduction to the liturgy: Water is a primary symbol in the sacrament of Baptism, and we have it in abundance in today's readings: Moses and the people in the desert longing for water, St Paul describing the love of God that 'has been poured into our hearts,' and the story of Jesus and the woman at the well. Listening to these inspired scriptures today, let us contemplate what the waters of our own Baptism mean to us.

HOLY WATER will be removed.

HOLY COMMUNION on the hand rather than on the Tongue is preferred.

COMMUNION FROM THE CHALICE (SH only) – refrain from the chalice if you have any cold or flu like symptoms. (a good idea at any time).
