## LENT

*There are three essential components to observing Lent; Prayer, fasting and almsgiving.*

### FASTING:

It is the Church's tradition that we do not eat meat on a Friday but during Lent it would be good if we could consider all forms of fasting, the custom of giving something up for Lent is a token gesture where as to live Lent properly means to fast for the whole season. We fast so that we might give....

**CAFOD Family Fast Day - Friday 6th March**, envelopes are available for collection at all Masses this weekend. CAFOD Lent Family Fast Day on March 6th is the 60th anniversary of the first Family Fast Day led by our founding mothers and, as it has been for sixty years, is an opportunity to reach out and support highly-skilled local experts around the world who help the poorest members of our global family. Please collect your Family Fast Day envelope this week and give whatever you can to help experts like Sister Consilia—a nun and trained pharmacist who treats people in rural Zimbabwe—continue their work.

### ALMSGIVING:

Almsgiving it linked to fasting! We deny ourselves in order that we might give to others. Giving of what we have surplus to our needs is not really giving at all. We give to others as an act of love, it is this real act of love that might begin to change the world and redress the imbalance of wealth in the world. It gives us the opportunity to reflect on our own greed and selfishness.

### PRAYER:

Prayer reminds us that it is in God that we find true peace and not in the passing things of this world. During Lent it would be good to try and come to Mass during the week. Please make use of the 'Walk With Me' booklets. We will continue the recent tradition of Holy Hour and Benediction on Thursday evenings 8 - 9pm. Stations of the Cross will be every Friday evening at 7.00pm and Sunday afternoons at 5.00pm. Alongside this there are the usual prayer groups and Masses. Perhaps we could all spend a little extra time in prayer this lent.
