Reopening of the Church for Private Prayer

The government has now cleared the way for churches to reopen for private prayer and we are happy that St Marie's will open in the coming week. There are still some restrictions which we need to follow.

- 1) The church will be open from 11am to 1pm and from 4pm to 6pm on Monday and Thursday
- 2) The reopening is for private prayer only. Come in and pray quietly. There is no permission for attendance at Mass or for group prayer such as the Rosary.
- 3) Social distancing will be necessary. Places in church will be marked for visitors.
- 4) Stewards will be present to explain the restrictions and to guide you. As in previous weeks, Mass will still be live streamed at 10am each day. This is a very important step forward, and we look forward to seeing you in church again.
