Face Coverings

Updated guidelines regarding face coverings

Face coverings will be mandatory in places of worship from Saturday 8th August 2020. All those who are attending churches must wear a face covering unless they are exempt from doing so. For Holy Communion the communicant should unloop their face covering and consume the Sacred Host and then replace the face covering before moving back to their pews in an orderly manner. This is for the good of all who gather in the church for mass as it is an enclosed public space where there are people from differing households who they do not normally meet.

You are also strongly encouraged to wear a face covering in other enclosed public spaces where social distancing may be difficult and where you come into contact with people you do not normally meet. Taken from:

Track and Trace

Collecting contact details of those who come to church for NHS Track and Trace

For the safety of all who attend mass, the government has advised that a contact phone number be kept for everyone who comes to mass, for a period of 21 days. That information will be destroyed after 21 days. It will be made available to NHS Track and Trace if they contact the parish to request that information. It will only be made available to any third party if that is required by law.

If you come to mass in a group or as a family only one contact number will be needed.

The legal basis on which the parish will hold this information is your consent. If you do not wish to provide your phone number for these purposes, you will still be able to attend mass.

Next Week's Gospel Reading Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time Matthew 16:21-27
