Blessed Joseph, to us too,

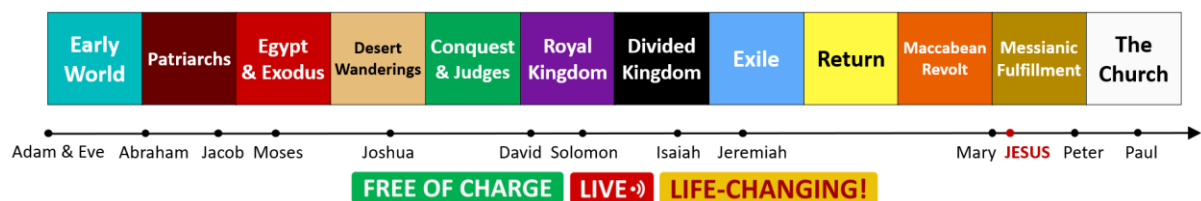
show yourself a father
